GRAPES	0.5 gal/acre	Apply first application at 4-6 inch shoot length, and repeat 2-3 times during the growing season. Apply in 50-100 gal water per acre.
DECIDUOUS FRUIT	1.0 gal/acre	Apply first application at second green-tip spray and repeat 2-3 times from 100% petal drop with 10-14 day intervals. Repeat after harvest. Apply in 100-300 gal water per acre or according to Tree Row Volume.
CEREALS Wheat, barley, oats	1 qt - 1.5 gal	Apply during the reproductive stage of the plants.

VEGETABLES	1 pt - 1 gal	Apply 2-3 weeks after germination and repeat 3-4 weeks later if necessary. Apply in 25-125 gallons of water per acre.
