DIRECTIONS FOR USE: USE ONLY AS DIRECTED.

- For optimum results, **GLUCO-ZINC** should be used in a program and in combination with other balanced fertilizers and foliar feeds.
- **GLUCO-ZINC** is compatible with most agricultural chemicals. **It is advisable to do a miscibility (jar) test prior to mixing.**
- **Do NOT mix GLUCO-ZINC with highly alkaline material such as Lime Sulfur and Bordeaux mixture or with any phosphate containing fertilizers.**
- **GLUCO-ZINC** should preferably be applied in the early morning or late afternoon. Do NOT apply to plants that are undergoing a period of moisture or heat stress.
- Consult with your chemical distributor should crop specific programs or any other information be required about the use of **GLUCO-ZINC**.
- Use lower rates as a maintenance spray and higher rates to correct deficiencies.

CROP	MAX RATE/A	REMARKS
CITRUS	40 oz	Apply as a full cover spray in spring to all new growth (2-3 applications). Do not spray directly before or during harvest. Apply in 200 gal water per acre.
CORN	28 oz	Make first application early in the season at the first signs of a deficiency and repeat if required. Apply in 20 gal water per acre.
ONIONS	2 qt	Apply at the first signs of a deficiency. Repeat application 2 weeks later if required. Apply in 50 gal water per acre.
POTATOES	28 oz	Apply at the first signs of a deficiency and repeat 3-4 weeks later if necessary. Apply in 50 gal water per acre.
WHEAT/BARLEY	28 oz	Apply early in the season at the first signs of a deficiency and repeat the application if required. Apply in 20 gal water per acre.
APPLES/PEARS	28 oz	2 applications per season. 1 early in the season and again after harvest in 50-200 gal water per acre.
BEANS, GROUNDNUTS, PEAS, SOYBEANS	28 oz	1-2 applications early in the growing season. Apply in 20 gal water per acre.
OTHER CROPS	14 oz	Apply as a full cover spray and repeat every 14 days as needed in 50 gal water per acre.
